- They can sometimes infer the central idea, purpose, and basic content of short spoken exchanges, especially when the vocabulary is not difficult.
- They can understand the central idea, purpose, and basic content of extended spoken texts when this information is supported by repetition or paraphrase.
- They can understand details in short spoken exchanges when easy to medium-level vocabulary is used.
- They can understand details in extended spoken texts when the information is supported by repetition and when the requested information comes at the beginning or end of the spoken text. They can understand spoken texts when this information is highly paraphrased.

- They can infer the central idea and purpose of a written text, and they can make inferences about details.
- They can read for meaning. They can understand factual information, even when it is paraphrased.
- They can connect information across all steps that, and they can make connections between two related texts.
- They can understand a broad range of vocabulary, including meanings of common words and idiomatic usage. They can also make distinctions between the meanings of closely related words.
- They can understand how-based grammatical structures. They can also understand difficult, complex, and uncommon grammatical constructions.
