



Catalonia is a region with a millennium-old tradition and its own language, Catalan, and autonomous government, the Generalitat, within Spain and the European Union. It has a stable political system—in fact, its Parliament is the oldest in the world (1283)—which promotes economic activity based on knowledge, in which higher education and research are key elements. Catalonia is a worldwide benchmark of excellence in research in areas such as biotechnology, photonics, energy and nanotechnology. It is research in close contact with universities, the principal mission of which is to discover and advance in knowledge that benefits society and brings about economic prosperity.

Catalonia has an area of approximately 32,000 km2 and a population of over seven and a half million inhabitants. A region which bears the mark left by the footsteps of different cultures and a historical heritage recognized by UNESCO.

History

The origins of the University of Lleida (UdL) go back to the medieval university, founded in 1300, which disappeared at the beginning of the 18th century when Philip V suppressed all Catalan institutions. Product of this tradition, in 1991 the new University of Lleida was founded.

Campus

UdL is structured into four campuses specializing in the teaching of one or more areas: the Cappont, Rectorat, ETSEA and Health Sciences campuses. The UdL layout model is that of diverse campuses within a city. Each campus aims to provide a university environment that is pleasant for work, study, research and debate.

Teaching

UdL is characterized by its offer of personal training, where the student is one of the main actors in the learning process. UdL degrees provide advanced training that is specialized and/or multidisciplinary based on quality content created by experts in the subject matter which is constantly updated.

The postgraduate studies are programmed based on an approach that aims to align teaching and research and demand rigorous academic performance. UdL is a university of reference in the agri-food and forestry fields, but it offers a wide array of quality training in Arts and Humanities, Human and Animal Health Sciences and the Social Sciences, as well as in Tourism, Education and Social Work.

Research

UdL has built an enterprising university model, where both basic and applied research play a key role in developing its strategy, oriented to the needs of social agents and the transfer of the knowledge produced with the aim of contributing to the growth and development of its environment.

To promote this strategy, UdL provides scientific and technical services, a comprehensive support tool for research available to the UdL's own research groups, those of other universities, public and private institutions and companies that wish to benefit from the human and technological potential available.

Innovation

The UdL Research Ring promotes the visibility of research and the transfer of knowledge produced by its teaching and research staff. The Ring is also intended as a way of improving the support mechanisms for carrying out research activity, grouping together the different UdL research institutes and the Agri-food Science and Technology Park of Lleida, a fundamental piece in structuring Lleida as an agri-food capital of the European region.

Internationalization
